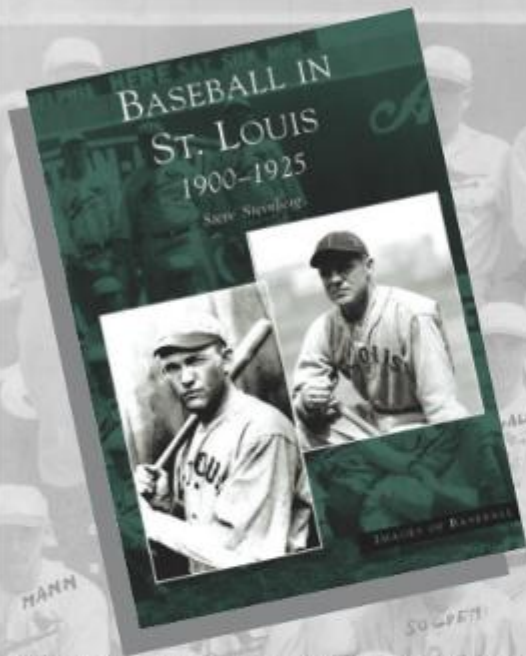


# Baseball in St. Louis: 1900–1925
